The IU Online **Master of Arts in English** provides broad training in English studies. As a student in the program, you explore the core principles of writing and literature pedagogy, the linguistic structure and history of English literature, and a wide variety of reading strategies associated with genre and close reading.

While the MA in English is open to any applicant wanting to pursue an advanced degree in English, **dual-credit teachers** needing to meet Higher Learning Commission (HLC) guidelines will find the degree especially useful. The HLC requires dual-credit teachers to hold a master's degree in their area of instruction or a master's degree in another area, plus at least 18 credit hours or graduate coursework in their area of instruction.

To earn this degree, you must first complete foundational coursework in one of the following online graduate certificates:

- **Composition studies**
- **Language and literature**
- **Literature**

Degree Requirements

To earn the MA in English, you must complete a total of 36 credit hours.

Requirements are broken down as follows:

- **English graduate certificate** (20 credit hours)
- **MA core courses** (8 credit hours)
- **MA elective courses** (8 credit hours)

Twenty (20) credits from your IU Online graduate certificate (see left) will apply to the MA in English degree requirements. Students who have earned credits from a different accredited college or university may transfer up to 4 credits.
